**ADVISORY 14/2017 : UPDATE OF SOFTWARE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF GST AT
UNIT RUN CANTEENS (URC)**

1. Further to this Dte letter No 95350/Q/DDGCS/Advisory /14-2017 dt 28 Jun 17 and representations from a number of URCs.

2. It is intimated that M/s Smart Chip Pvt Ltd has been asked to prepare and run a software patch to CIMS upgrade version 5.11 and CIMS + 6.02 which will disable the present restriction of demand creation of items already in inventory, which was imposed to prevent chances of dual inventory.

3. To minimize operation issues on ground once the restriction on demand creation is disabled, the URCs should ensure the following:-

(a) Avoid demanding items in stock unless the particular item/index is totally liquidated or demand items which are very less in stock.

(b) If demand of already available items is inescapable, then avoid creating any dual index number or new index number by adding different suffix. Instead keep entire quantity (fresh demand and stock balance) on one single rate by utilizing price revision report already available in CIMS/ CIMS plus. Post GST Price should be preferred. (price of items post GST is being disseminated through CSD Depots).

4. In case this is not done, the URC may face some operational problems on ground. Some of the possible problems are be as follows:-

(a) Canteen using same index number with different suffix for one item and selling same item on two rates can lead to customer complaints.

(b) Problems in accounting due to double inventory.

5. It is also intimated that SCPL will not be responsible for accounting issues and other problems arising when canteens resort to demanding an item already in inventory and creating dual inventory by taking it on charge in CIMS/CIMS Plus with a different rate and index number suffix or carry out any unauthorised modification.
