


GRANT OF UPGRADED PAY SCALES TO THE FIRE FIGHTING STAFF IN MINISTRY OF DEFENCE
AS PER VI CPC RECOMMENDATIONS

1. A copy of MoD ID No. 26(59)/2014-D(Civ-I) dated 02.12.2016 on the subject cited above alongwith its enclosures is forwarded for necessary action and dissemination to Estts under your control.
2. It has come to notice of MoD that a fake letter bearing No. 2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28.07.2010, has been created by some miscreants for misleading the administrative authorities. Taking note of this, instructions were issued to all concerned vide MoD/D(Civ-I) ID No. 26(59)/2014-D(Civ-I) dated 09.03.2015, to find out the source of the forged letter, and confirm that the payment of salary and allowances to the concerned Fire Fighting Staff was being made on the basis of pay scales/grade pay prescribed only under MoD letter No. 2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28.07.2010 or according to bogus letter.
3. MoD/D(Civ-I) has now requested for confirmation in this regard vide para 6 (i) & (ii) of MoD/D(Civ-I) ID note under reference and ensure the followings:-

(i) A report pertaining to establishments under your control may be forwarded to this office at the earliest for onward submission to MoD/D(Civ-I).

(ii) Instruct the establishments under your control to download the copies of MoD letters/orders uploaded in the MoD/DoD Website/Employees Corner only, from time to time, to avoid such recurrence, as applicable.

3. As for the four grade promotional scheme applicable to the civilian drivers as extended to the Fire Engine Drivers, they may continue where they exist at present. However, in the remaining establishments, the posts of Fire Engine Drivers shall be merged with the Fire Fighting Cadre.

4. These orders will be effective from 01.01.2006. The initial pay fixation as on 01.01.2006 will be done in accordance with the note 2 below Rule 7 of the CDS (RP) Rules, 2008.

Shri Om Prakash had submitted an application dated 18.7.2014 under the RTI Act 2005 for providing a copy of the MoD letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28 July 2010 on the subject above.

2. Shri Om Prakash was informed by the CPIO vide letter of even No. dated 15 September 2014, that the above mentioned letter does not exist in the record of this office as it was never issued. However, CPIO provided to him an attested copy of MoD letter No. 2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28 July 2010 (**Annex.1**). The applicant then made an **Appeal** to the Appellate Authority for providing the copy of MoD letter No. 2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28 July 2010. The Appellate Authority considered the appeal and rejected it on the grounds that there is no separate letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28 July 2010 in the MoD, and a certified copy of MoD letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28 July 2010, (as mentioned in Annexure-I) has already been supplied to him.

3. Shri Om Prakash filed his **second appeal** before the CIC, alongwith a copy of the MoD letter No. 2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28 July 2010 (**Annex.2**). This letter contains the stamps of different offices/ Dtes, their Dy. Nos/ dates, etc. As already stated above, such a letter has not been issued by the MoD, and its contents, like Pay scales/ Grade Pay of the Fire Fighting Staff mentioned in this letter, are also different from the contents of letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28 July 2010 issued by the MoD. Therefore, the letter dated 28.7.2010 made available by Shri Om Prakash is a fake letter.

4. Apparently, the MoD letter No. 2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28 July 2010, a fake letter, has been created by some miscreants for misleading the Administrative authorities in Defence Establishments including pay disbursing authorities. Taking note of this, instructions were issued to all concerned vide MoD/D(Civ-I) ID No.26(59)/2014-D(Civ-I) dated 09.03.2015, to find out the source of the forged letter, and confirmed that the payment of salary and allowances to the concerned Fire Fighting Staff was being made on the basis of pay scales/ grade pay prescribed only under MoD letter No. 2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28.7.2010.

5. In response to this, Controller General of Defence Accounts (CGDA) have confirmed that payment to the Concerned Fire Fighting Staff under their Audit jurisdiction has been made on the basis of pay scales/grade pay prescribed in MoD letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28.07.2010. CGDA has also confirmed that they have not received the MoD letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28.07.2010.

6. The appellant, in his second appeal before the CIC, has also produced a copy of the advertisement published by MoD/Naval HQ in the Employment Newspaper dated 24-30 January 2015 (**Annex.-3**), calling for applications for appointment to the post of Fireman Grade-II in the Indian Navy in the PB-1 with GP Rs.2000/-. This pay structure of Fireman Grade II is incongruent with the Pay Scale/Pay Band (as per 6th CPC) prescribed in MoD letter dated 26/28-07-2010. In view of the documents produced by the Appellant before the CIC, all concerned are requested to please take the following actions:-

- (i) Confirm whether the payment of salary and allowances is being made to any of the member of concerned Fire Fighting staff on the basis of pay scales/ grade pay prescribed under MoD letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28.7.2010 or according to fake letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 28 July 2010;
- (ii) Confirm whether the advertisement published by Indian Navy in the Employment Newspaper showing Fireman Grade-II in PB-1 with GP Rs.2000/-, is genuine, If yes, then a report may be sent to us as how the pay scale of Fireman Grade-II differs from provisions of MoD letter No.2(1)/2009-D(Civ-I) dated 26/28.7.2010;

Verify the authenticity of stamps/ Dy.Nos./Dates of different Dtes/ Offices of the letter at **Annex.-2**.

As precautionary measure, all the Line Dtes/ Def. Estts. Must also to be advised to download the copies of MoD letters/orders uploaded in the MoD/DoD Website/Employees Corner only, from time to time, to avoid such recurrence.



2. The total no. of vacancies indicated against all posts are inclusive of vacancies reserved for PWD/Ex-SM categories. The PWD/Ex-SM selected will be adjusted against the UR/SC/ST/OBC category to which they belong.

3. AGE RELAXATION:-

(i) For SC/ST Candidates: Relaxable upto 05 (Five) years as per Govt. orders on the subject for the posts reserved under this category.

(ii) For OBC Candidates: Relaxable upto 03 (Three) years as per Govt. orders on the subject for the posts reserved under this category.

(iii) For Physically Disabled Candidates (Unreserved Category): Relaxable upto 10 (Ten) years as per Govt. orders on the subject.

(iv) For Physically Disabled Candidates (SC/ST Category): Relaxable upto 15 (Fifteen) years as per Govt. orders on the subject.

(v) For Physically Disabled Candidates (OBC Category): Relaxable upto 13 (Thirteen) years as per Govt. orders on the subject.

(vi) For Ex-Servicemen: Length of Military service increased by 03 years subject of GOI orders amended from time to time and upto a maximum of 10 years in case of PWD category. Candidates subject to existing Govt. Order.

(vii) For Central Govt. Employees: These concessions are admissible as per subject to the conditions laid down:-

(a) The direct recruitment post in Gp. 'C' services are in the same line or allied cadres and a relationship could be established that service rendered in the Department/Posts will be useful for efficient discharge of the duties in the other categories of post.

(b) Where an employee has rendered not less than three years continuous service under Government (and not on ad-hoc basis) as on the last date of submission of application will be eligible for relaxation wherever applicable in the column 03 of Para 1 (a) in (i) above.
