**SUPPLY AS WELL AS CHECKING OF GAUGES
ISSUED FOR PROOF OF SHOT GUNS TO TRADE FIRMS**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the competent authority to supply to the trade firms, gauges used for proof of Shot Guns, as well as to render checking facilities on these gauges, on payment, by Controllerate of Quality Assurance (Small Arms), Ichapur.

2. The details of the cost to be charged by the Controllerate of Quality Assurance (SA), Ichapur for supply/ checking of various gauges shall be as follows :-

- * Goods & Service Tax (GST) wef 01 Jul 2017 at the applicable rate shall be charged alongwith cost of gauge and cost of periodical inspection of gauge.
3. Trade Firms will make their own arrangements to take delivery of the new gauges from CQA (SA), Ichapur. They will also make their own arrangement to submit the gauges for checking if desired and to take delivery of the same after checking.
 4. All payments towards the cost of the supply of new gauges and the cost of periodical checking of the gauges as per rates indicated at para 2 above alongwith applicable Goods & Service Tax (GST) wef 01 Jul 2017 are required to be paid in advance in the form of bank draft. Bank draft will be drawn in favour of the Controller, Controllerate of Quality Assurance (SA), Ichapur at State Bank of India, Barrackpore. Extra postal charges will have to be paid by the trade firms, if the gauges are sent to them by post. While adjusting the payment, the Goods & Service Tax (GST) wef 01 Jul 2017 shall be transferred to the respective local taxation office through specified challan immediately, whereas the amount realized on account of the cost of supply of gauges & periodical inspection of gauges, will be credited to the government under Major Head - 0076 Defence Services Army, and Minor Head - 109, Inspection Organisation.
 5. If the gauges are despatched by post to or from CQA (SA), the government will not be held responsible for any loss or transit damage.
 6. Proper care shall be taken by trade firms for preservation or packing of the gauges despatched to CQA (SA) by post.
 7. These orders will be valid for a period of three years wef 2nd Aug 2016 and upto 1st Aug 2019.
 8. These orders will be reviewed after a period of three years or earlier considered necessary from the date of issue of Govt of India letter notifying the revised rates.
 9. This supersedes Govt of India, MoD Letter No. 62564/ GAUGES/ DGQA/ ADM-16TC/786/D(QA)/2016 dated 02 Aug 2016.

10. This letter issues with the concurrence of Defence (Finance) branch vide their RF No. 1(3)/2016-IF(DS) dated 21 Sep 2017.
